How to change the look and feel of Izenda Reports with CSS Styles

Warning: Never apply any styles/master pages to the rs.aspx page. Do not alter the rs.aspx page(or create a new code behind for the page) in any way without first consulting Izenda Technical Support.

Procedure

Included in this zip file are three CSS files. These files are named "Reports.css", "tabs.css", and "toolbar.css". Please be aware that these file names are case sensitive, do not change the file names. You will need to place these files where Izenda Reports can access them. The files may need to have read permissions added to them depending on your configuration. Always make sure that the "NETWORK SERVICE" or "ASPNET" machine account has access to the files. Now, the basic process for altering them is as follows:

1. Make your changes to the CSS styles in the files.
2. Now tell Izenda Reports to use your files. Do this by setting the following properties, ReportCssUrl, TabsCssUrl, and ToolbarCssUrl, in your global.asax file found in the root of the Izenda Reports directory. A code sample showing how to set each is given below, the settings are highlighted:

public override void ConfigureSettings()
{
    AdHocSettings.SqlServerConnectionString = INSERT_CONNECTION_STRING_HERE";
    AdHocSettings.LicenseKey = "INSERT_LICENSE_KEY_HERE";

    AdHocSettings.ReportCssUrl = "http://www.izenda.com/adhoc5/Report.css";
    AdHocSettings.TabsCssUrl = "http://www.izenda.com/adhoc5/tabs.css";
    AdHocSettings.ToolbarCssUrl = "http://www.izenda.com/adhoc5d/toolbar.css";
}
```

3. Now that they are set, refresh your browser and clear its cache completely. You should then see the changes you have implemented.
